2020 Graduation Ceremony

Mayor Vergano is pleased to be able to help facilitate the graduation ceremonies for both Wayne Valley and Wayne Hills High Schools. In order to help insure a pleasant and safe experience for all, the following guidelines must be followed:

1. Students MUST wear face coverings during the procession. All individuals are strongly encouraged to wear appropriate face coverings.
2. Chairs will be set up six (6) feet apart and should not be moved. Social distancing of at least six (6) feet MUST be maintained.
3. If an individual, including graduating students, has a temperature of 100.4 F or greater, they are NOT permitted to attend the graduation ceremony. Individuals who are sick should NOT attend the graduation ceremony. Signage will be posted discouraging anyone from attending if they or anyone in their household is experiencing symptoms of respiratory illness or COVID-19 in the past fourteen (14) days.
4. Programs will be distributed electronically prior to the graduation ceremony.
5. All guests MUST maintain a social distance of six feet. However, family groups may sit together.
6. Chairs will be cleaned before and after being used.
7. The ceremony will occur entirely outdoors.
8. There will be no restrooms available.

Any individual who does not comply with the above-noted requirements will be required to leave the municipal property.

PLEASE BE ADVISED that the Township has taken all recommended precautions from local, state and federal health officials to prevent exposure to COVID-19 at the graduation ceremony. If you are an individual who is susceptible to serious illness if exposed to COVID-19, please consider staying home to avoid possible exposure. As stated above, signage will be posted discouraging anyone from attending the graduation ceremony if they or anyone in their household is experiencing symptoms of respiratory illness or COVID-19 in the past fourteen (14) days or has a temperature that exceeds 100.4°F or greater.
