

Sir,

In reference to a response to an emergency at any interior parking garage to which includes the Avalon Bay building on Valley Road & Barbour Pond Road. The only vehicle that the Wayne Fire Department has in its fleet is a 2014 Ford F550 Mini-Pumper that is located @ Community Volunteer Fire Co # 1 , 93 Parish Drive, Wayne NJ, which is 4.9 miles away, approximately 12 minutes distance. This Mini-Pumper has a height of (07) seven Feet, (05) five inches and its main purpose is for brush fires. This height is with a full tank of water, once it exhausts its water supply, it may raise a couple of inches in height.

To properly extinguish a vehicle fire, Mini pumper would have to connect to a standard fire engine which would supply more water, then enter the parking structure to wherever the Vehicle Fire is to deploy water. This mini Pumper has only one 1 ¼ inch pre-connect hose line that we use for car fire and because its main purpose is brush fires, it does have two 1 inch hose lines, but these are not efficient to fight car fires. Please let me know if you need any more information on this matter.
