



Here are the 3 ways you can vote in the upcoming Primary Election...

1. VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT



Registered voters can apply for a **vote-by-mail ballot** by following the instructions found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV** or contacting their County Clerk.

Then, VOTE and RETURN your ballot one of the following ways...

- *Mail:* Your vote-by-mail ballot **MUST** be postmarked on or before **8:00 p.m. on June 7** and be received by your county's Board of Elections on or before June 13.
- *Secure Ballot Drop Box:* Place your vote-by-mail ballot in one of your county's secure ballot drop boxes by 8:00 p.m. on June 7. Drop box locations can be found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.
- *Board of Elections Office:* Deliver your vote-by-mail ballot in person to your county's Board of Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. on June 7. County Election Officials' contact information can be found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.

2. IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING



This option enables all registered voters to cast their ballot **in person, using a voting machine, during a three-day period prior to Primary Election Day**. You can choose to vote, in person, when it's most convenient for your schedule.

No matter where you live in the county, you can vote your specific ballot at any of **your** county's designated in-person early voting locations. Find your county's locations at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.

In-person early voting locations will be open **Friday, June 3 through Sunday, June 5**. Hours will be **Friday-Saturday, 10:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m. and Sunday, 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.**

No appointment is necessary. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

3. AT YOUR POLLING PLACE ON PRIMARY ELECTION DAY



Vote in person at your polling place, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. **on Primary Election Day, June 7**. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

Go to **VOTE.NJ.GOV** for your polling place, listed on the Polling Locations page.

NOTE: Vote-by-mail ballots CANNOT be returned to your early voting location or polling place.

IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING BEFORE ELECTION DAY

Due to a new State law, you now have the option to vote in-person, using a voting machine, during a three-day period prior to Election Day. No matter where you live in Passaic County, you can vote your specific ballot on a voting machine at any one of the below designated in-person Early Voting locations.
